John Coleman

John Coleman - Inducted: 1996 Elevated to Legend: 1996

Champion full-forward who was a high-flying goalkicking genius. His strength one-on-one was brilliant and he was not intimidated by any opponent. His playing career was tragically cut short by a knee injury.

The 'King' in a dominant Essendon era. His roving skill, leadership and class in using the football was unparalleled. One of four triple Brownlow Medallists.

Bill Hutchinson - Inducted: 1996 Elevated to Legend: 2003

Fit, fearless and creative rover who was a key figure during Essendon's golden era. A brilliant goalkicking rover, Hutchinson formed a potent roving combination with fellow AFL Legend Dick Reynolds. A two-time Brownlow Medallist, Hutchinson also won 7 Essendon Best & Fairests.
